Bougies are useful adjuncts in those difficult intubation settings. They differ from regular intubation stylets in that they have more length and less rigidity. Commonly used to "railroad" an endotracheal tube into the trachea, bougies can also be used to facilitate replacing a damaged ETT and confirming ETT placement following intubation.

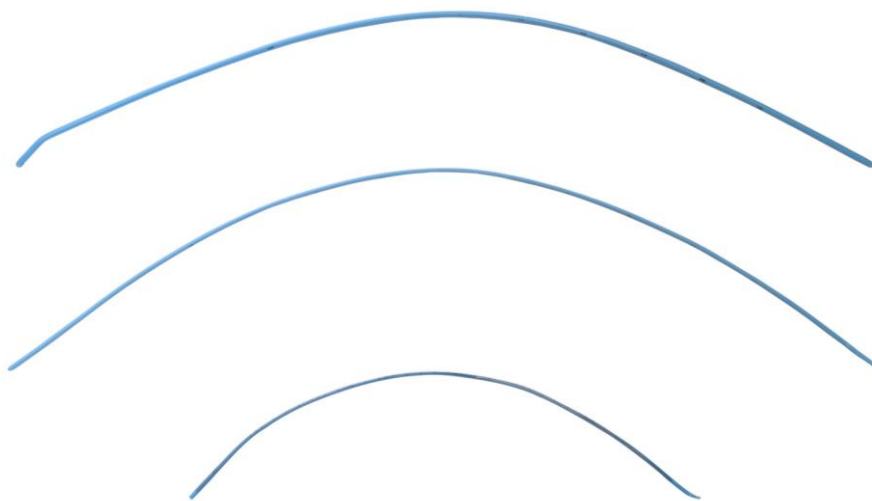
